



VISAS AND AIRPORT TAXES

Visa Information

Whether you need a single entry visa (\$25.00), a double entry visa (\$40) or a multiple entry visa, the validity is 90 days from the date of entry.

Zambia has a list of **167 countries who do not require** a visa to enter the country. The full list is available on the link provided above.

Amongst these, are The United Kingdom and Ireland, China, the United States of America, Germany, Norway, Sweden, Belgium and South Africa.

In order to obtain a visa on arrival, the visitor must have full information of his/her host and be able to provide physical address where they will be staying for the duration of their stay. They must also have at least six months validity on their passports from the date of entry and the passport must also have at least 3 full blank pages.

Those arriving in Zambia by Air must be in possession of valid return air tickets. Those arriving by land and water must have enough funds for their stay in and departure from Zambia

An e-Visa is an official document permitting entry into and travel within Zambia. It is an alternative to visas issued at Immigration Headquarters, Zambian Missions Abroad and at the ports of entry. Applicants obtain their visas electronically after entering required information and making payments by a credit or debit card.

All persons who ordinarily require visas to come to Zambia are eligible to apply for e-visas.

Airport Departure Taxes

Airport departure taxes are levied on all departures from international airports in Zambia.

The current charges are:

International Flights: \$25 departure tax and \$5.00 Security Tax (sometimes included in the ticket price, but not always)

Domestic Flights: \$3.00 security tax (usually included in the ticket price but not always)
